## FRIDAY, JULY 12

### RACE 1

- 5 – CHEERS HANOVER – Impressive debut at Pocono
- 2 – FASHION GREEN – Campbell Stable always does well here
- 7 – DIVE BAR HANOVER – Second in first career effort, raced well
- 1 – SENSATIONAL – Good prep race at Pocono

### RACE 2

- 7 – COALFORD BET ALINE – Very good first local start
- 8 – SKYLINE INDY – Has gate speed to overcome the post
- 4 – ROCK LOBSTER – Won last start, returns today after 5 months off
- 1 – EA LUCKY HILL – Has speed, but is risky due to breaks

### RACE 3

- 3 – MESHUGGAH – Showed high speed at Pocono
- 5 – ELAN HANOVER – Second place finisher in both lifetime starts
- 7 – KING OF GREEN – Needs to avoid early speed battle
- 6 – BOMBAY TOM – Raced well in both PopUp Series starts

### RACE 4

- 4 – BONNIPRINCLOUIS N – Hasn't raced in a month, hope he's ready
- 8 – RISENSHINE SEASIDE – Always a top finisher locally
- 6 – LITENINGONTHEBEACH – Sharp right now, has won 2 straight
- 2 – AMERICAN FLING – Inside post draw doesn't hurt
- 7 – SPRING INHIS STEP A – Newcomer from Hoosier is worth a look

### RACE 5

- 5 – FATHER TJ – Fast final quarter on the straightaway at Hoosier
- 6 – ARROWHEAD HANOVER – Tough trip at Pocono
- 7 – GIMLET HANOVER – Broke at 6-5 last start, try him again
- 3 – CANTAB ZETTE – Top-3 finisher in all career starts

### RACE 6

- 4 – MUNSTER MASH TRICK – Has yet to lose in qualifiers or PM races
- 5 – SCUDO HANOVER – Back-to-back second place finishes to start his career
- 2 – ANDOVERS HOTROD – Added trotting hobbles and won at Meadville fair
- 3 – MR HOPPER – Two wins so far, can hit the ticket here

### RACE 7

- 6 – TROYCEN – A closer, needs quick fractions up front
- 5 – MIND YOWN BUSINESS – Might use his gate speed here
- 7 – REDWHITE N GOO – Made a big move last week
- 4 – I LOVE MY MVP – Consistent top finisher in recent weeks
- 3 – HOLTON – Trotted a quick mile last week

**RACE 8**

- 3 – SET THE BAR – Won All Star race at Pocono last time
- 4 – OWLS NEST – Fourth last time, can improve a spot or two
- 6 – GOT LUCKY DE VIE – Won locally two starts ago
- 1 – ONEMORE VOLO – Needs a quick start from inside post

**RACE 9**

- 6 – UNCENSORED – Ships from Canada for a reason
- 4 – CREDIT TO FRANK – Had no chance last week due to trip
- 1 – BLUE PATROL – Made a move in final turn at Pocono
- 7 – BELL HALL – Getting faster with every start

**RACE 10**

- 2 – KEYSTONE WINDSOR – Showed speed last week at Pocono
- 1 – MESSENGER HANOVER – Made a break while in contention last week
- 6 – APEROL HANOVER – Raced well in first lifetime start
- 4 – MANOLO HANOVER – Fourth in both starts, can improve a spot

**RACE 11**

- 8 – DISTANT DRUMS – 4-for-4, hard to pick against
- 2 – FATHER MIKE – Just missed last start
- 9 – BIRD AND GRENADE – Big comeback after early break last start
- 4 – READY FOR LANDING – Might use his gate speed this week

**RACE 12**

- 7 – SHORT ORDER – 1-for-1 since arrival from eastern PA
- 3 – RJ'S FIREBALL – Newcomer has shown speed at Hoosier
- 4 – SEAWIND SERPENT – Third last week despite a poor post
- 8 – BARON HILL – Joins new stable, ships from Ohio

**RACE 13**

- 6 – THREEPOINTBLUECHIP – Consistent top finisher in this level
- 1 – HEIST – Trotted sub-1:54 mile after going first-over last time
- 5 – MOMONI DE VIE – Impressive win last time after missing a month
- 3 – BATTIN ATHOUSAND – Good win against older horses last week
- 9 – K J ALEXANDER – Another outside post, has gate speed
