## PENNSYLVANIA HARNESS RACING

Welcome to the 2025 Pennsylvania Harness Fair Racing Season and prepare for racing. This year The PA State Horse Racing Commission will help oversee racing at 14 Fairs and 5 2Day Events. The Fair season starts June 25-26 at The Butler Fair and ends on October 4-5 at the Dayton 2Day Event. Fair Finals will be held at the Pocono's Racetrack on Monday, October 13, 2025, for both 2yr and 3yr-olds.

In Pari-Mutuel Racing, the 2025 PA Sire Stakes/Stallion Series Standardbred Harness Racing will be hosted at our 3 Pennsylvania tracks, Harrah's Philadelphia Racetrack, Meadows Racetrack, and Pocono Downs Racetrack. The season for 3yr-olds starts May 3rd at the Meadows and ends August 30 at the Meadows, with Championships being held September 6th at The Meadows Racetrack. The 2yr-olds' season will start July 2nd at the Meadows and finish August 28th at Pocono's, with Championships held on September 5th at Harrah's. The Stallion Series Finale for both 2yr and 3yr-olds will be held September 8th at Pocono's.

With 108 fairs throughout Pennsylvania for the 2025 season, the 14 fair's and 5 2day events that host Harness Racing set themselves apart with the thrill of live racing for both competitors and spectators. We hope you'll use this guide as your roadmap to excitement and fun for the whole family. Which events will be looking forward watching?

## PENNSYLVANIA HARNESS RACING RULES

All participants in Pennsylvania fairs and one or two-day Harness racing events must be licensed by the State Horse Racing Commission Bureau of Standardbred Racing. Participants (owners, trainers, and drivers) must all be members of both PHHA (Pennsylvania Harness Horsemen's Assn.) and PFHHA (Pennsylvania Fair Harness Horsemen's Assn.) in order to be covered for any sulky damage that occurs while participating at the events included in this book. To be eligible to the Sire Stakes program, the mare of the resulting foal must be on the list of 140 US mares bred submitted by the Pennsylvania farm that stands the stallion. If the mare is not on the list, the foal is not eligible to the Sire Stakes Program.

No driver will be permitted to drive in a race unless he or she is wearing a protective safety helmet of a type satisfactory to the commission constructed with a hard shell and containing adequate padding and an adequate chin strap in place, as specified in United States Trotting Association rule 17, sec 12. Any person not complying with these directives will be subject to a fine and/or suspension.

Helmets must be manufactured in compliance with the 1984 Snell "H" Harness Racing Standards of the Department of Transportation 218 Standard. This directive is applicable to all persons in Pennsylvania while engaging in any harness racing activities sanctioned by the commission. All drivers competing in races should wear safety vests of a rating of five or better, as defined by the British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA), to provide shock-absorbing protection.

If a race is split in two or more decisions, horses in an entry shall be seeded in separate divisions in which they compete by owners, trainers, or stables, and their post positions shall be drawn by lot. If a trainer owns more than one horse in a race, he cannot drive another horse in the race; he can pick if he owns two or more in a race.

Trainers must have mud gear, to include mud fenders, for use at the discretion of the presiding judge.

The Bureau of Standardbred Horse Racing will collect random blood samples from horses that participate in fair racing. The purpose of sample collection is to maintain and protect the integrity of fair racing in Pennsylvania.

Fair racing Judges decisions are final and are not able to be appealed.

## HARNESS RACING AT FAIRS

All fair racing is subject to the rules and regulations of the State Horse Racing Commission Bureau of Standardbred Horse Racing.

Horses for overnights must show a charted line on the declared gait for 2025 with no breaks behind a pari-mutuel track starting gate within 2:15 for trotters and pacers.

For the safety of all competitors, fields will be limited to one trailer behind the gate.

Starting fee for overnights is \$25, with declaration to be added to purse. The purse will be distributed as follows: 50-25-12-8-5 if five starters or more; 50-25-15-10 if four starters; 55-30-15 if three starters; 65-35 if two starters; and 100 in case of walk over.

Fair management reserves all usual rights and releases from responsibility for accident, fire, theft, or any other cause.

Exact order of races on each fair's daily program is determined at the draw and should be checked.

Any additional or special conditions, in addition to race dates appear on the page designed for each fair in this edition.

In order to comply with federal regulations: An IRS form W-9 must be completed upon payment of entry fees and prior to racing for owners who are US citizens.

A W-8 and 4224 Form must be completed and submitted for owners who are not US citizens. The federal ID# or SSN# must match the first name listed on ownership. Purse monies will not be released unless these form(s) are submitted.

## 2025 FAIR EQUINE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

1. All Pennsylvania equines must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued after May 1, 2025; Non-Pennsylvania equines must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) issued within the 30 days prior to the opening date of the exhibition. If an animal comes from a state where Vesicular Stomatitis (VS) has been identified, or a bordering state, the CVI shall include a statement verifying that "All animals identified on this Certificate of Veterinary inspection have been examined and found to be free of VS, During the past 90 days, these animals have neither been exposed to VS nor located within 10 miles of a state where VS has been diagnosed."

2. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases.

3. An animal owner or Caretaker's Verification of Veterinarian-Client-Patient Relationship (VCPR) form must accompany each animal and presented upon arrival at the exhibition.

4. All equine animals must test negative for equine infectious anemia (EIA) by an official test within the 12months prior to the opening date of the exhibition.

A copy of the official test results must accompany each animal to its final destination. Foals less than 6 months of age accompanied by a dam that meets the above requirements are exempt for EIA testing requirements. If the foal is not accompanied by the dam, a copy of the dam's test results must accompany the foal to its final destination.

5. A current rabies-vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian is required for animals 3 months of age and older. All vaccine label directions must be followed, and all rabies vaccinated equine animals must either be accompanied by a rabies vaccination certificate, or the vaccination information must be included on the CVI. If a rabies vaccination certificate is provided, the certificate must contain a legible name and contact information of the veterinarian who administered the vaccine and his or her signature. A copy of the rabies vaccination certificate is acceptable.

6. If an equine has resided in Texas or New Mexico for a cumulative total of 30 days or more within the 6 months preceding the date of entry into Pennsylvania, that animal must test negative for Piroplasmiasis on a competitive enzyme-linked "c-ELISA" test, or a department-approved equivalent test, with the test occurring within the 30 days preceding entry into Pennsylvania. The written laboratory test report, confirming compliance with the requirement described above, shall accompany the equine in transit to a destination within Pennsylvania and the date of test and results shall be written on the CVI.

7. All horse owners must show proof of the EIV/EHV (rhinovirus and influenza) vaccine for each horse every six months.

## FAIR SIRE STAKES CONDITIONS

The Sire Stakes fund encourages horsemen to breed and buy top-level stock in Pennsylvania. The fund offers a rich series of races for two-and-three-year-olds that meet "Pennsylvania-eligible" conditions.

The fund is administered by the Bureau of Standardbred Horse Racing with guidance from the Standardbred Breeders Advisory Committee.

1. These events are subject to the authority of the Bureau of Standardbred Horse Racing and the applicable rule of the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture.

2. Each competitor must have been sired by a registered stallion standing in Pennsylvania from February 15 through July 4 of the year of conception.

3. All races are to be one-mile dashes. Horse must show an acceptable line at a pari-mutuel track with timer, generated on or after May 1, 2025, within the following time standards (including variant: no hmt allowance):

- 2:10 for 2YO trotters
- 2:06 for 2YO pacers
- 2:08 for 3YO trotters
- 2:04 for 3YO pacers

This line would qualify horses of either age to race the entire fair season, subject to the horse being put on a fair judges list or otherwise prohibited.

4. Charting will be done at several fair tracks throughout the season and will be allowed only at tracks hosting events in this fair guide. If a horse does not meet qualifying standards, the horse must qualify at a pari-mutuel track during regularly scheduled, multi-horse races.

If you would like charting to be done at another fair, it is up to you to pay the charter directly.

5. All 2YO and 3YO fair starts must have two full days off between starts. Example: a horse raced on Monday cannot race at a fair until Thursday.

6. It is the trainer's responsibility to enter only horses eligible to race. If a horse is entered and subsequently determined not eligible and thus scratched, the entry fee must still be paid.

7. Material in this book notwithstanding the presiding judge, after consultation with the horsemen and fair management, has the final word on how many starters or trailers can be Raced safely on a given fair track. If a race is split, a method of division from the Bureau of Standardbred Horse Racing Rules and Regulations will be adopted.

8. The presiding judge will meet with a designated horsemen's representative and the race secretary before the days first race to determine a track variant, which will then be announced. The variant can be adjusted and re-announced during the day if weather changes necessitate.

## FAIR SIRE STAKES CONDITIONS

9. All Sire Stakes events will be raced in separate colt and filly divisions.
10. Starting fees Group A: \$75 and Group B: \$50 will be payable to the host track and added to the purse. Nominating and sustaining payments are to be sent to the Pa Sire Stakes.
11. The Group system used towards determining championship horses will be 35-25-10-8-5-2, per the order of finish. A rain out will generate a horse 9 points. A horse who is an official starter but does not finish on his or her own accord will get 0 points.
12. Should circumstances prevent the racing of any event, purse monies will be pro-rated among owners of horses set to race in a division at the time of declaring off. Horses do not have to be on the grounds, but the entry fee must be paid before a check is released.
13. Any horse who is “double-entered” at any two tracks (including fair and pari-mutuel) and then scratched from a fair race will be liable for both the starting fee at both fairs if involved (\$50 each to the two) and a \$100 fine, both payable before the horse may start again at a fair.
14. A judge may put a horse on a “fair judges’ list” for unsatisfactory performance and will specify the number of days before the horse can go to a pari-mutuel track to attempt to requalify. The list will be made available from the commission office under normal circumstances, and all judges will have phone numbers and e-mails, when possible, for any judge who may have to draw before the commission office would reopen.
15. A functional starting gate is required to conduct fair racing.
16. In the event of inclement weather or track safety concerns, The State Horse Racing Commission-assigned judge will have a final say on whether to race or cancel. This is done so after consulting with horsemen, track crew, and the starter.
17. An ambulance designated strictly for racing is required to be on site 1 hour prior to the first post.
18. All horses must be on the grounds 1 hour prior to their scheduled post time.
19. Random blood gas testing may take place at each fair event.
20. All entrants in the fair finals must have FIVE starts at PA fairs or two-day events. Starts in both the A and B divisions count towards the minimum start requirement. Group A point earners with at least five starts will have priority for the final from highest to lowest points; followed by those horses that had minimum number of starts within the A and B Division. In the case of a points tie, the tie breaker will be total money earned in the current year at PA fairs. No horse with less than five programmed starts will be allowed to race in the fair finals.

## PA SIRE STAKES FUND (FAIR DIVISION)

These events are subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Pennsylvania State Horse Racing Commission and the applicable rule of the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture.

Each yearling must have been sired by a registered stallion standing in Pennsylvania the full season of service (2023) during which the dam was bred to produce such foal. To be eligible to the Sires Stakes program, the mare of the resulting foal must be on the list of 140 US mares bred submitted by the Pennsylvania farm that stands the stallion. If the mare is not on the list, the foal is not eligible to the Sires Stakes Program.

A copy of the USTA or other approved registration certificate is to accompany each nomination.

Each race is to be a mile dash.

Horses must show a charted line on the declared gait after May 1st with no breaks in the following time standards (with time allowances). Official workouts do not apply. Each trainer is responsible for knowing the conditions of eligibility of their horses.

2-Year-Old Pace .....	2:06
2-Year-Old Trot .....	2:10
3-Year-Old Pace .....	2:04
3-Year-Old Trot .....	2:08

The Judge or his designee shall decide if the field should be split for safety purposes. In the case of a split in the event, the association conducting same may divide the race by adopting one of the methods of division racing then current in the Pennsylvania State Horse Racing Commission Rules and Regulations. For purposes of cancellations the Judge’s decision is final.

Gait must be declared by the March 15, 2026, payment. Transfer may be made at the time of declaration but starting payments remain in the respective funds.

All 2-year-old and 3-year-old starters must have 2 full days off between starts. Ex: Horse raced on Monday cannot race until Thursday.

All 2-year-old and 3-year-old races will be raced in separate colt and filly divisions.

All starting fees will be added to the purse and will be paid to the track conducting the event. All other payments to Pennsylvania Sire Stakes Fund.

If less than 3 horse’s enter in any B Class Events, Divisions may be combined at the discretion of the Race Secretary.

## PA SIRE STAKES FUND (FAIR DIVISION)

Should circumstances prevent the racing of any event, all monies available will be prorated among horses declared in for the un-contested event at the time of declaring off; horses do not have to be on the grounds, but the entry fee must be paid before a check is released.

Points are awarded based on order of finish, in this manner: 35 points for first, 25 points for second, 15 points for third, 10 points for fourth, 8 points for fifth, 5 points for sixth, 4 points for seventh, 2 points for eighth, per the order of finish. A rain out will generate a horse 9 points and count as a start. A horse who is an official starter but does not finish of his or her own accord will get zero points. Scratches receive no points. DNFs receive no points but are credited with a start. In the case of a dead-heat for finish position, the points for that position and the one(s) under it will be added and divided by the number of horses in the dead-heat. The points are to be used to determine eligibility for any championship races that may be offered in that particular year; qualifying standards for such Fair Championships shall be those of the host track.

- Only points earned in Group A are eligible for the Fair Finals
- If you win 3 out of 4 starts In Group B you must move up to Group A
- Finishing 1st or 2nd in Group A you must remain in Group A

### Future Eligibility:

If a 2-year-old makes the required March 15 payment(s), they need not make the respective May 15 payment in order to be eligible at 3, but they are then ineligible at 2. Supplementary payment may be made to this stake on the foals of 2023 upon payment of \$250 between May 16 and December 31 of the yearling year, and \$500 between January 1 and March 15 of the 2-year-old year (plus the sustaining fees due on that date). To maintain eligibility all future payments may be made as regularly required. A \$750 late penalty payment may be made by March 15th of their 3- year-old season if the 1st 2-year-old sustaining payment was not made plus the sustaining fees due on May 15, 2026.

### Disputes:

In the case of any disputes as to the interpretation or subsequent revision of these conditions, the decision of the Commission shall be final. All fees and payments in any race are accepted on the condition that all claims, objections, and appeals arising out of these races or with respect to the interpretation of any rules or conditions of the race, or otherwise, shall be decided by the Commission.

### \*\*\*SPECIAL NOTE\*\*\*

Fair Final fields will be limited to 8 starters. Only 8 horse to run in each Fair Final Race.

### \*\*SAFETY AND EMERGENCY PROTOCOLS\*\*

1. In the event of an accident, all actions and procedures will be directed by the acting judge at the event
2. Number one priority will be to attend to injured driver(s). Emergency personnel should take necessary action and direct all activities relating to driver injuries.
3. In the event a horse goes down, the attending Veterinarian must have access to the horse and take necessary action in coordination with the acting judge.
4. In the event of a horse and/or driver going down, and if the field would be required to pass the down horse/driver in order to complete the race, then the race should be declared a no contest. All starters of this race will be awarded the same points as if a rain out was declared.
5. People and vehicles are not to cross the track without supervision during warm-ups and racing.
6. At any track that scores 4 horses or less on the starting gate, all horses must turn to the right upon entering the racetrack and travel counterclockwise (race direction) even during warmups. The acting judge has the final say on this or any other rules pertaining to the safety of all participants.

### FIRST AID AND AMBULATORY EQUIPMENT REQUIRED AT ALL TIMES

Always remember, swift action is critical in the event of a racetrack accident. The welfare and safety of ALL "humans and Horses is of the UTMOST IMPORTANCE".

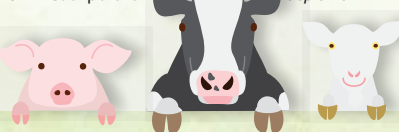
